May:

Throughout these unsettling events I was still in school getting ready for summer. The things that did effect us were hearing things like that we had surpassed 100,000 coronavirus deaths. Something that made me really sad and that probably shocked everyone was seeing George floyd was killed at the hands of police. Another thing that had me edge was seeing the protest and the aftermath. I would be watching the protest on TV to hear an entire police precinct had been burned down. There was rioting in Philadelphia and across the country.

June:

Not long after George Floyd's was killed at the hands of police. There was lots of talk of change and I agreed. In addition to that I was thinking about what my summer was going to look like with all of the covid stuff happening. Something good that came out of the pandemic is that I made a really good friend. Around June 24th I got my cat. My family and I got him so I could have a little friend to keep me company through school and being home alone most of the time.
