Some people ages 15-18 go to technical secondary school for 3 years. Others ages 15-18 go to upper secondary school for 3 years. Then you can do vocational school for 3 years, tertiary school for 4 years, tertiary for 4 years, 2 years, & 4 years for different diplomas. But after Secondary school 7-9 grade, school is no longer mandatory.
